As independent and duly qualified statutory auditor, I have examined the attached financial statements of HURIDOCS, Human Rights Information and Documentation Systems, International, Geneva at December 31, 2009, which have been prepared under the accounting policies generally acceptd in Switzerland.

Respective responsibility of the Executive Board, Management and auditors

The Association's Executive Board and the Management are responsible for the preparation of the financial statements. It is my responsibility to form an independent opinion, based on my examination, on those statements and to report my opinion to you.

Basis of opinion

I conducted my audit in accordance with the Swiss Standard on Limited Statutory Examination. This standard includes examination, on a test basis, of evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. It also includes assessment of the significant estimates and judgments made in the preparation of the financial statements and of whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Association's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

I planned and performed my audit so as to obtain all the information and explanations which I considered necessary in order to provide sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatements, whether caused by fraud or other irregularity or error. In forming my opinion I also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of information in the financial statements.

Opinion

In my opinion, the accounting records and the financial statements comply with the law and the statutes. I recommend that you approve these financial statements disclosing a net deficit of CHF 12'719 at December 31, 2009.
