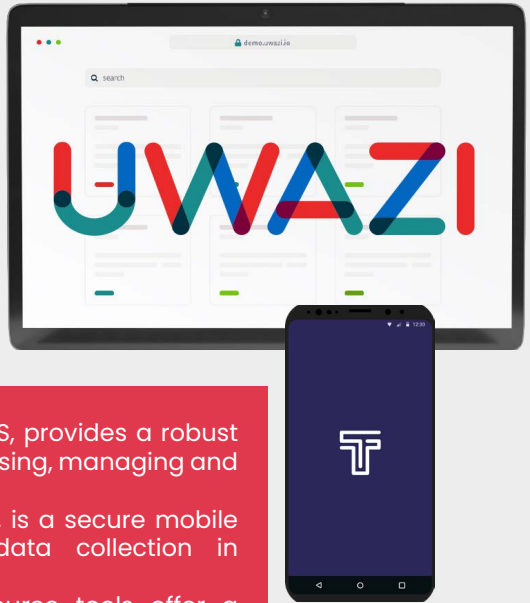


Uwazi + Tella: A powerful integration



- ▶ Uwazi, developed by HURIDOCs, provides a robust and flexible platform for organising, managing and sharing data.
- ▶ Tella, developed by Horizontal, is a secure mobile app designed for offline data collection in challenging environments.
- ▶ Together, these two open-source tools offer a more secure and efficient solution for human rights defenders to collect data in the field, organise it and store it.

Why Uwazi + Tella?



High-quality documentation

Built-in camera and audio recorder



Customisable templates

Uwazi templates to organise data and create relationships between assets



Offline mode

Collect data offline and upload when internet becomes available



Security

End-to-end encryption of data, sent directly from Tella to Uwazi



Camouflage

Hide or mimic the Tella app in case of device seizure



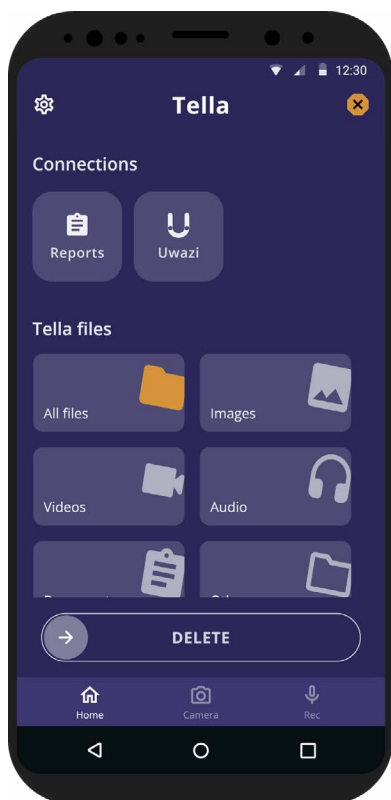
Multilingual support

Uwazi can be localised into more than 180 languages while Tella is available in 17 languages



Privacy

Data recorded with the app is only accessible within Tella



Simple steps to get started:

- 1 Install:** Download and install the Tella app on Android or iOS
- 2 Lock:** Create a Tella PIN or password.
- 3 Collect:** Create, import and organise media and files.
- 4 Connect:** Enter Uwazi url and credentials to connect to an Uwazi server.
- 5 Organise:** Use custom and pre-defined Uwazi templates.
- 6 Select language:** Set the language for ease of use.
- 7 Submit:** Upload data directly or submit it later when there is a stable internet connection.
- 8 Start documenting!**

The Tella app is available in Android, iOS and F-Droid
